Governor Idris approved the increased monthly cash allocation from 5 to 15 Million on monthly basis, paid the new minimum wage and the long awaited consequential salary adjustment coupled with implementation of 4 years outstanding annual increments arrears. Approval of 1.5 Million Naira monthly for security enhancement. Approval of 119 Million Naira. The Governor graciously appointed the University Governing Council for its importance on oversight and policy guidance. A University that operates MBBS and Nursing Sciences is regarded as a prestigious institution and in that aspect the Governor earlier on approved 10 Million Naira Monthly to cater for personnel cost. The big blow came even though not as a surprise for those that know the international Unionist and role model where he also approved the sum of N449,193,400.8 to support the College to prepare for its accreditation requirements knowing the importance and cost implication attached to it coupled with assisting the student on payment of Nelfund and Scholarship.

The reader will want to asked wether we forgot to mention Senator Aliero's achievements and support to the University as a former Governor, Minister and now a Senator he had in many ways stood and pushed the University's positive interest and during one of his visit and stake holders meeting he made a generous donation of Solar lights, Inverters, motor cycles, constructed a female hostel block rehabilitated the central mosque of the University and pledged an official vehicle to

the Vice- Chancellor. Senator Aliero recently brought additional block of hostel, mini grid, students recreation centre and made a generous donations of 10 Million Naira to the recent students Calender launch, proposed 20 Kilometres road. The above efforts showcased our leaders love and fashion to the young but fast growing University in the North Western Nigeria.

The Honourable Minister of Humanitarian and Poverty Reduction Rt. Hon. Dr. Yusuf Tanko Sununu, has consistently demonstrated remarkable support, passion and goodwill towards the University. His tireless and unwavering commitment deserves to be remembered, appreciated and highly commended.

The above efforts made by our leaders was done purposely to promote the image and recognition of the University to the highest heights and that significant milestone will ever remain in the development archives of the University.

Additionally, the appointment of Engr. Prof B. G. Danshehu as the 3rd Substantive Vice- Chancellor is another land mark achievement considering his leadership experience and exposure further opened other opportunities from the indigens of Kebbi State and beyond. His collaboration with Engr. Ahmed Umar Farouk the Managing Director of the Nigerian Air Space Management Agency (NAMA) donated financial support to the University which was used in handling some key Projects. In a similar development a partnership was extended with Abubakar Sadiq Yelwa Managing Director National Hydro Electric Powers Producing Areas Development Commission. N. HYPPADEC where it assisted in providing additional boreholes and made some maintenance with a view to add to the supply of water around the hostel. The Pension Premium had also



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Constructed additional Borehole at the Junior staff Quarters, contact was also made with the National Energy Commission, The Ecological Fund, who all made a pledge to the University.

It is on this background and in consideration of the purpose of establishing the University was to venture into character shaping giving out standard knowledge and research that will equip the students who definitely will be leaders of tomorrow. It is in this premise that we are calling on the well to
